
The **person icon** in the upper-right corner will give you access to:

- My Library (to see resources uploaded/created, Playlists, etc.)






EXPLORE DISTANCE LEARNING SUPPORT



Click on the toggle "Show Distance Learning Resources" to view instructional activities that are recommended for remote learning.

Click on "Distance Learning Support" for teacher resources, such as the Distance Learning Teacher's Guide, tutorials, videos, *etc*.

Notice that you have access to:



From the Grade Level TOC, select the Unit, Week, and Lesson of your Choice. The selected Lesson will open in **RealizeReader**.




Grades 3-5




Select Unit Introduction. Notice the Unit Launch Video.


From the **Unit TOC**, select a **Week** of Instruction.

EXPLORE THE WEEKLY RESOURCES




Notice the **Weekly Assessments**, **Lessons**, and **Writing Workshop**.

In Lesson 1, notice the **Book Club**- Unit Trade Book.


In each lesson, notice the built-in support as you Assess & Differentiate, including myFocus Reader.






On the "My Library" tab, assign the Playlist to a whole class, small group, or individual student.

EXPLORE ESSAYSCORER (GRADES 3-5)




From the **Assessments & Practice** menu, choose **EssayScorer**.




From the Grade level TOC, click Tools, then select **Scout**.

Scout is an observational assessment tool that allows teachers to:

- Take notes on casual observations
- Use guiding questions and rubrics for planned observations
- Track progress of student fluency
- Capture student audio, photos, and videos
- Upload student artifacts
- Score Weekly Writing Workshop Assessments




